- 1. All course fees are to be paid by the first week of the month. A penalty charge of \$5 will be levied after the 15th of the month. No reminder letters or invoices will be given. The Conservatory reserves the right to suspend or terminate the students' lessons until all outstanding fees are paid.
- 2. New students upon enrolment pay a non-refundable registration fee of \$76.50/- as well as a one-month advance fee.
- 3. Fees are payable throughout the year, inclusive of dates when the Conservatory is closed ("Mandeville Holidays") and public holidays. Students are advised to commit the time allocated for lessons as the teachers have packed schedules. We understand that there may be, in the rare occasions, the need to change the time slots due to unforeseen circumstances. Such requests can be made known to the teacher and is subject to the teacher's and studio's time availability. If the instructor is absent, the instructor will arrange for the replacement of lessons. Alternatively, the Conservatory will arrange for a relief instructor to take over the class.
- 4. To terminate lessons, one month (4 weeks) advanced written notice must be given failing which the advance fee will not be refunded. Upon notification of termination, the remaining 4 weeks of lessons will be made good subject to the instructor and the Conservatory's availability. All lessons are to be taken within the period of 4 consecutive weeks from the date that the Conservatory receives the notice of termination. No additional replacement lesson will be made if a lesson falls on a public holiday or a Mandeville Holiday.
- 5. Students who absent themselves for any length of time must continue to pay fees. Otherwise, the Conservatory reserves to right to terminate the student if he/she fails to pay within a month from the time when fees are due.
- 6. Students may be considered dismissed if they miss lessons for more than 3 times without giving prior written notice. No refund will be given.
- 7. For special courses such as Pre-Schooler Music Exploration Course, Baby Violin, Baby Music and other short-term courses, fees are to be paid by the term. There will be no refund of course fees should the student choose to withdraw from the class.
